Screen Repairs

Small Holes (1/4" to 3/8") You can patch small holes with a small amount of household cement. This glue patch will be next to invisible.

Note: Fiber-glass and plastic screens are tougher to patch.



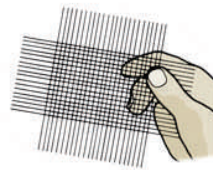
Large Holes

1. Measure the size of the hole.
2. Purchase ready-made, snap-on repair patches at your local hardware store or cut a patch from a new piece of screening.



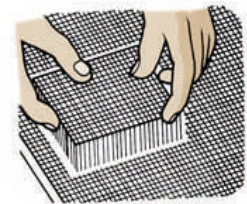
Note: The patch should be at least 1/2" - 1" larger on all sides than the hole itself.

3. Unravel several strands from the patching material or use a ready-made, snap-on patch.



4. Slip the bent strands of the patch through the screening, then

bend them back to hold the patch in.



Note: You can usually bend the strands with your fingers, but if the patch is heavy duty, you may need long-nosed pliers. Plastic patches need a touch of household cement on the ends of the strands after they've been woven through.
