6 in 1 Screwdriver- Has phillips and slotted tips along with 2 different

sized nut drivers. It doesn't hurt to have several of these.



25 ft Tape Measure - Compact enough for small scale work but stretches for bigger tasks.



Utility Knife (box knife) - Great for cutting just about anything from vinyl floor and roofing

shingles to cardboard. Buy extra blades and change them often.



Adjustable Wrenches - a 6 inch and a 10 inch should cover almost any job.



Receptacle Tester - A must for electrical inspections and

mapping your circuits.



Torpedo Level - A nice compact tool that works well for when hanging pictures, shelving and small carpentry projects.



24 inch Level - For big and small tasks. You may not use it often but you'll be glad you have it when its needed.



Stud Finder - Use it to find the "studs" in your walls for hanging artwork, shelves and more. They work!

Beginning Woodworking Classes

Have you always wanted to learn how to make your own furniture? Here's a class you don't want to miss! This class is taught by Tracy Gray, a custom cabinet builder and professional instructor. Tracy has also been a speaker at our monthly ["Do It Yourself Denver" Meet Up](#) group. This two-session course begins with a discussion of wood technology, machine and shop safety. While building a small table out of hardwood you will learn how to use the jointer, planer, table saw, and power miter saw. In the second session you will finish dimensioning your table parts and assemble them with a pocket hole jig system. Routing edges and sanding will round out the day to complete the table. An excellent class to get into woodworking or refresh your shop skills.
