### March

- Prepare yard for the summer use rake leaves Cut rose bushes Cut back perennials.
- Trim trees.
- Thin old, overgrown deciduous shrubs.
- Deep water trees and shrubs as needed.
- Apply Merit for year long control of leave chewing insect in your deep root fertilizations program.
- Plant a new tree.
- Trim crabapple and American elm now
- Winter water small trees and shrubs if needed
- Check yard for tree and shrub branches that may be damaged by snow
- Make sure you brush heavy snows from your evergreen branches
- Start planning for flower, perennial and vegetables
- Begin weeding those beds not cleaned in fall
- Schedule deep root watering for large trees if soil not frozen
- Schedule plug aeration and 1st fertilization for turf
- Schedule Crabgrass treatment
- Schedule Plant Health treatments for Ips Beetle, Ash Borer and Pine tip moth

## Habitat Needs Your Help

"Here's a great opportunity to increase construction skills while making new friends and helping Habitat...

Volunteers are needed to help install sheds sold at Habitat's two Outlet stores. The sheds are partially pre-fabricated at a framing warehouse, and installation volunteers then meet a crew leader at the shed owner's address to help assemble the shed. Some experience with construction is preferable, and volunteers must be at least 18 years of age or older. Sheds are generally installed on weekdays (Wed, Thurs, or Fri) and volunteers are asked to commit to approximately 4 hours (9:30-1:30). Ideally, Habitat is seeking volunteers who are willing to commit to this program on a regular (weekly/bi-weekly) basis, but all levels of participation are needed.

All proceeds from sales at both Habitat's Outlets are returned to Habitat of Metro Denver to continue to build more homes throughout the Denver metro area for families in need of affordable housing."
