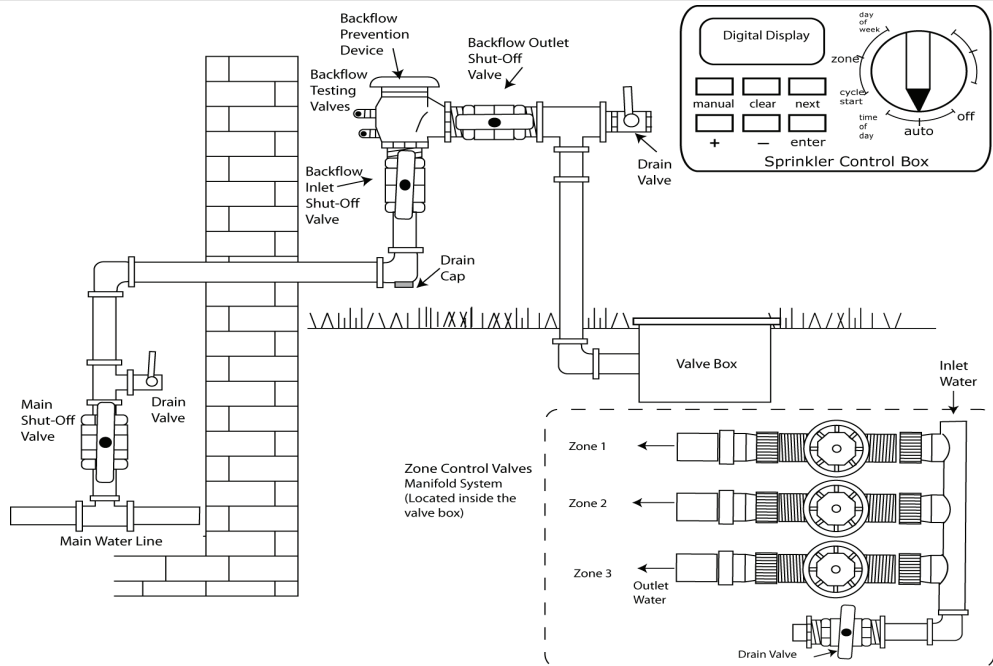

Main Shut Off Valve - The valve where you can shut off the main water supply to your house.

Back Flow Prevention Device - This is a device used to protect your main water supply from contamination (required)

Backflow Shut-off valves - Valves used to shut off the water supply to or from the back-

flow device.

Drain Cap - Opened when draining and 'blowing out' the system.

Control Box - The programmable device used to define the watering times and quantities for each zone in your system.

Zone Control Valves - Located in a "Valve Box" These valves

control the water flow to each zone in your system.

Drain Valve - Used when shutting down and starting up your system each season.
