Did You Know ?

- About 15 million tons of new drywall are produced in the U.S. every year.
- About 12 percent of the drywall used in new construction ends up as scrap.
- Builders of new homes in the U.S. typically generate about 3,000 pounds of wood, 2,000 pounds of drywall and 600 pounds of cardboard as waste for the average 2,000-square-foot home.

Drywall Repair - Tools & Materials

The following is a list of tools that are recommended for anyone planning to do drywall repair themselves. To purchase these tools, stop by [Ace Hardware - Alameda Station](#) at Broadway & Alameda and look for the **Workshop for Women** display.



Names: Joint Knife, Taping Knife, Broad Knife

Use: to spread joint compound or 'mud' on drywall patches or joints.



Name: Joint Compound, Mud, Patching Compound

Use: to fill holes and cracks or to cover drywall tape or patches on joints or holes.



Names: Keyhole, Saw, Jab Saw, Wallboard Saw

Use: A small hand saw that can be used to cut and trim holes in drywall



Names: Utility Knife, Box Knife, Box Cutter, Razor Knife

Use: used to cut, trim or clean up drywall.



Name: Drywall Tape, Joint Tape, Drywall Bandage. (We recommend the fiberglass mesh tape for use in repairs)

Use: to cover seams or joints between sheets of drywall and to repair cracks and holes in drywall.



Names: Putty Knife

Use: to spread joint compound or "mud" when patching or repairing drywall.



Name: Sandpaper

Use: to clean drywall before patching, to smooth "mud" between coats when patching.
